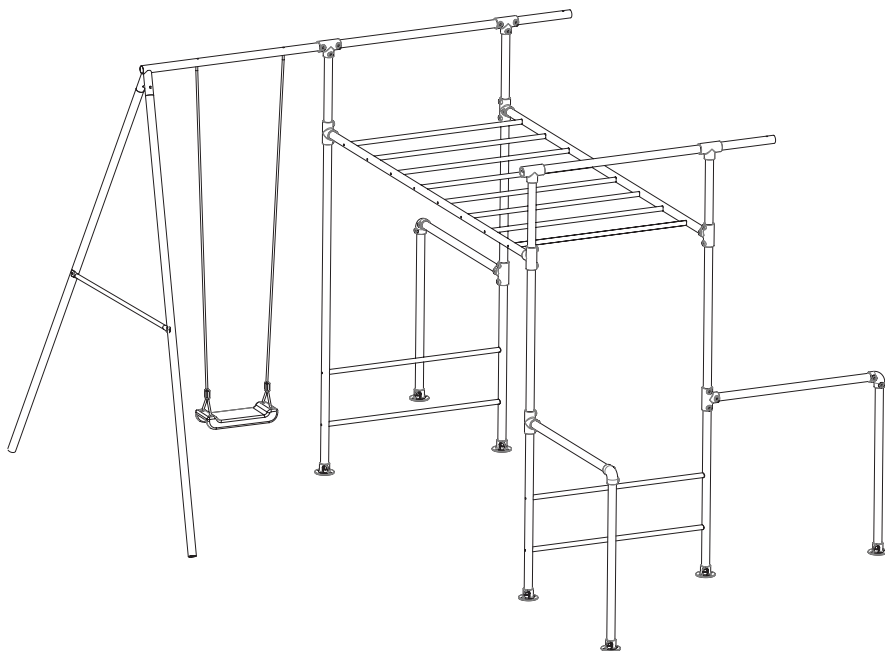

WARNINGS!

1. For Children 3+ years.
2. Not for children under 3 years due to small component which may cause choking hazard.
3. Only for domestic use! This product has not been designed for commercial use in play centres, nurseries etc.
4. Only suitable for outdoor use.
5. Not for children with a body weight over 80kg. Only one child per seat at any one time.
6. The total weight on the product at any one time must not exceed 250kg.

Instructions for assembly, maintenance and safe use.

Please retain this information for future reference.

1. This equipment must be assembled and checked by an adult. Two adults may be required to assemble this product.
2. Adult supervision is always required.
3. Check all nuts and bolts for tightness and tighten every time before use.
4. Oil all metallic moving parts.
5. Check all coverings for bolts and sharp edges every time before use, and replace when required.
6. Check swing seats, ropes and other means of attachments for evidence of deterioration. Do not use the swing if deterioration is found.
7. Place the product on level surface at least 2 meters from any structure or obstruction such as a fence, garage, house, wall, overhanging branches, laundry line or electrical wires.
8. **The anchors MUST be concreted into the ground. Anchors shall be placed level with or under the ground in order to reduce tipping hazards.**
9. DO NOT install the product over concrete, asphalt or any hard surface.
10. DO NOT orientate the product directly towards the sun.
11. DO NOT allow children to wander into the play area whilst the equipment is in use.
12. Regularly check the item for wear and damage, removing the item from use when necessary until replacement parts are fitted.
13. Failure to assemble and maintain this item as per instruction may cause injury to the user.
14. The minimum clearance between the swing seat and ground level should be 350mm.
15. Swings must not exceed an angle of 60 degrees from the ground.
16. The maximum fall height for the product is 234cm.
17. This equipment should **ONLY** be used when it has been properly assembled and used in the manner as intended.
18. Any changes to this equipment including change or adding an accessory, must be one in accordance with our instruction. Failure to do this will void your warranty and make your product unsafe.
19. Remove all packing before giving to children.
20. Never place toys near fire.
21. In high winds, ensure outdoor toys are moved to a sheltered position and/or securely stake down.
22. In freezing weather, detachable plastic part should be stored inside.
23. Equipment should be checked by an

Information sheet for playground surfacing materials

The surface under and around the playground equipment can be a major factor in determining the injury-causing potential of a fall. It is self evident that a fall onto a shock absorbing surface is less likely to cause a serious injury than a fall onto a hard surface. Playground equipment should never be placed on hard surfaces such as concrete or asphalt and while grass may appear to be acceptable it may quickly turn to hard-packed earth in areas of high traffic. Shredded bark mulch, wood chips, fine sand or fine gravel are considered to be acceptable shock absorbing surfaces when installed and maintained at a sufficient depth under and around playground equipment.

Table below lists the maximum height from which a child would not be expected to sustain a life-threatening head injury in a fall on to four different loose-fill surfacing materials if they are installed and maintained at depths of 150mm, 225mm & 300mm.

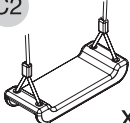

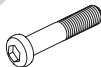
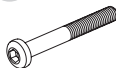
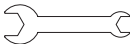
However, it should be recognised that all injuries due to falls cannot be prevented, no matter what surfacing material is used.

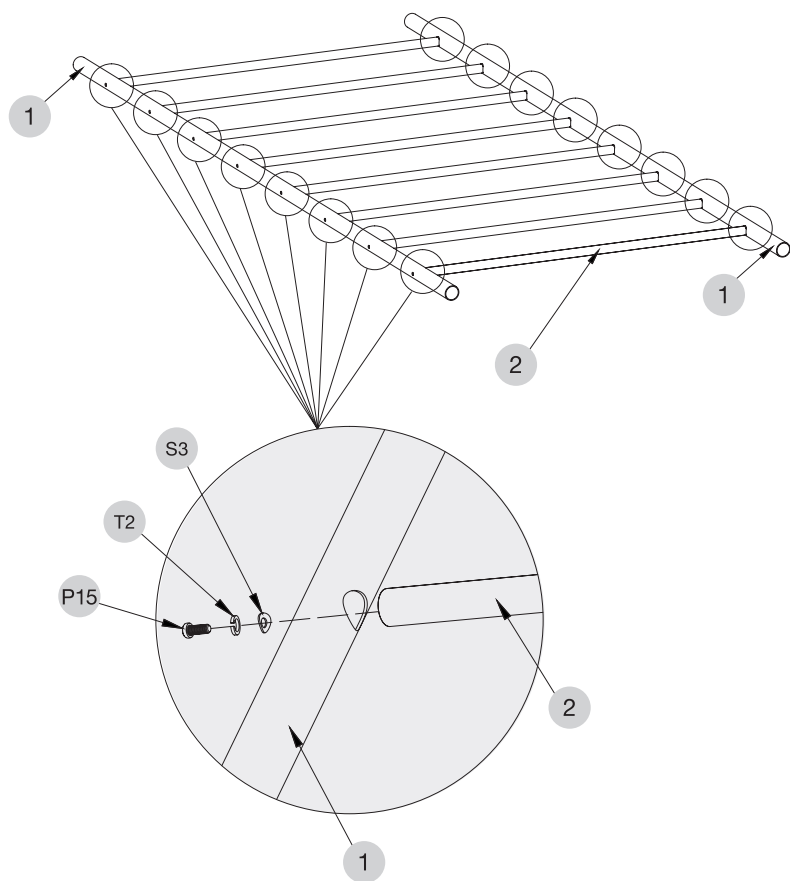
It is recommended that a shock absorbing material extend a minimum of 1800mm in all directions from the perimeter of stationary equipment such as climbing frames and slides. However because children may deliberately jump from a moving swing the shock absorbing material should extend in the front and rear of a swing a minimum distance of twice the height of the pivot point measured from a point directly beneath the pivot on the supporting structure.

This information is intended to assist in comparing the relative shock absorbing properties of various materials. No particular material is recommended over another. However each material is only effective when properly maintained. Materials should be checked periodically and replenished to maintain correct depth as determined necessary for the equipment in question. The choice of material depends on the type and height of the playground equipment, the availability of material in a particular area and it's cost.
